Rules & Regulations:

- 1. Participants, maximum of 8 students per act, must be students (public, private or home schooled) in grade Kindergarten through Twelfth or the equivalent.
- 2. Participants must reside in The Town of Yarmouth or be involved in a "group act" that has at least one participant who resides in Yarmouth.
- 3. The Yarmouth Music Boosters encourages diverse acts. Acts can be musical, theatrical, dance, artistic, literary or demonstrate any other creative talent.
- 4. Acts should expect to perform on camera as part of a YGT Online video.
- 5. Acts will be divided by grade level into K-4, 5-8 and 9-12. If an act with multiple performers includes students in different grade levels, the act will be placed in the grade level of the oldest student. Exceptions to this rule will be at the discretion of the Music Boosters.
- 6. The Music Boosters will determine the order of the acts for the show.
- 7. All entrants must submit an audition video online at yarmouthsgottalent.org.
- 8. Acts should not exceed 4 minutes performance time.
- All acts should be appropriate for a diverse audience that will include K-12 students, families and friends and should reflect Yarmouth's Core Values: Honesty, Integrity, Trustworthiness, Loyalty, Fairness, Caring, Respect, Citizenship, Pursuit of Quality, Responsibility, Positive Self-Esteem.
